SKT is submitting information to show that it provides broadband service in areas targeted by the “Cox Communications Sedgwick G15” Capital Project Fund Grant application.

In the Public Project Proposal, Cox Communications indicates that it would serve the town of Rosalia.

SKT is in the final stages of a fiber upgrade in Rosalia, with mainline construction complete, and splicing near completion. Customer installations will begin in the next 6-8 weeks, allowing 80 homes/businesses in this area access to 2 Gbps symmetrical fiber broadband.

This fiber upgrade makes the grant application dollars unnecessary and allows funding to be focused on areas with greater need.

The FCC 477 Map indicates that SKT offers 75/10 Mbps in Rosalia, which will be outdated soon due to this fiber upgrade. For documentation, refer to the SKT Rosalia Fiber Project landing page at SKTC.net/rosaliafiber.
